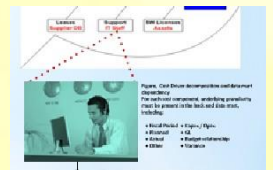

What does IT cost? Assess the cost of your offerings in terms of the customer's perspective (services) vs. technology nuts and bolts. Analyze service value, drive down unit costs, modify user behavior, articulate service architecture to customers.

Careful monitoring of cloud providers demands a granular view of their provisions and the means by which they charge for services. This is true for all suppliers of IT. Staff responsibilities include financial assessment of technology providers.

Financial accountability — departmental owners are the ones best equipped to consider next year's needs. Their accountability is imperative for savings and investment. Collaboration with Finance is modeled for budgeting based on IT services.
